We also would like to thank Patrick E McGovern in helping us with the dates on our vinicultural chronology.

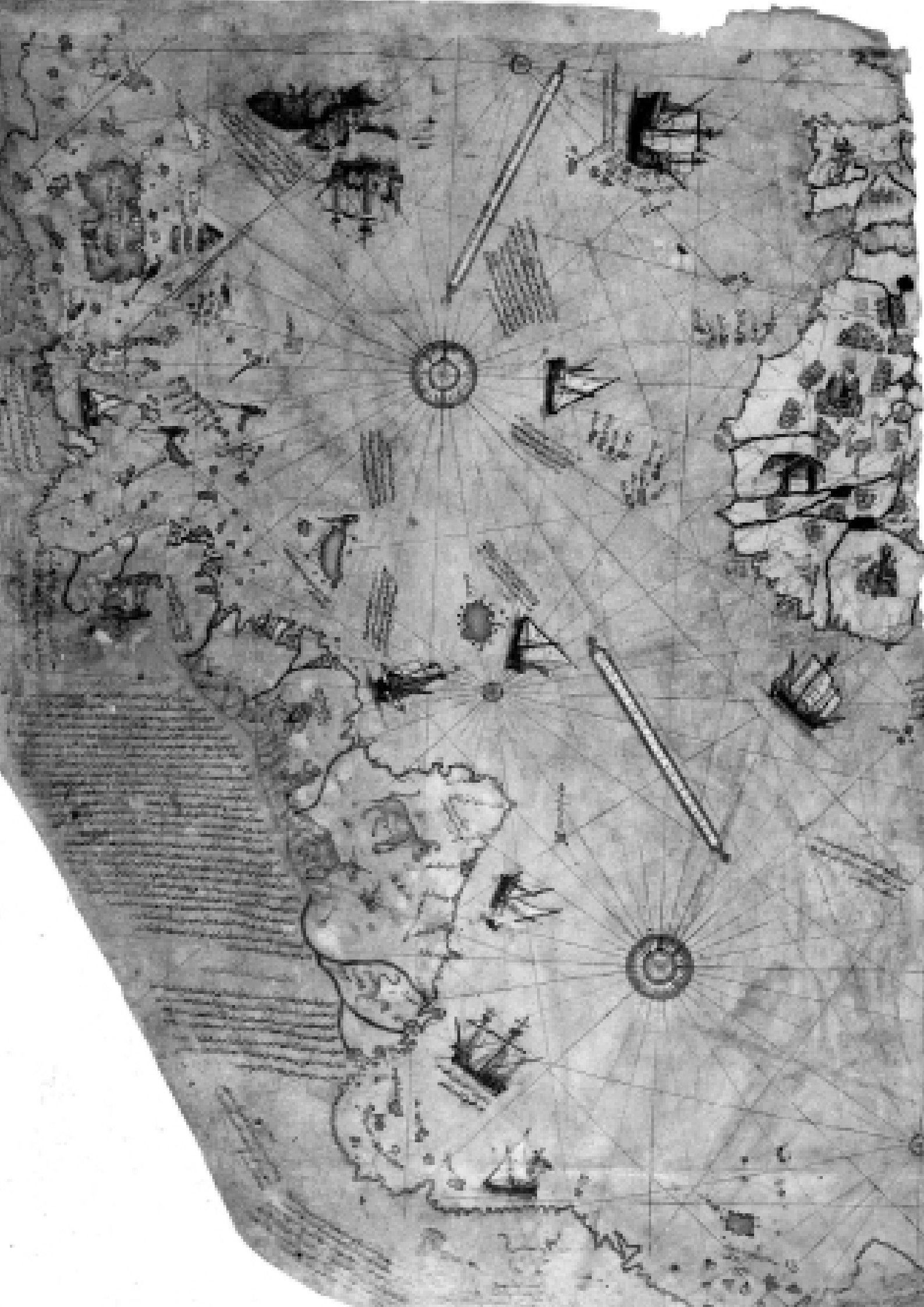
